MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW JULY 2022

July was cold, cloudy month with above average rain.

The rainfall total of 72.6 millimetres was 25 mm higher than the average. Most falls were light with the exception of 46.2 mm which fell on the 5th/6th.

Day temperatures were close to normal, but overnight minimums overall were milder than normal despite a number of severe frosts.

There were no notable temperature extremes.

It was a partly cloudy month with only ten sunny days, and winds were mostly light to moderate westerlies which is normal for mid-winter.

Noteworthy events:

5th/6th: Moderate rain which fell in the afternoon and evening of the 5th and morning of the 6th totalled 46.2 mm for the 48 hours to 9am on the 7th. This resulted in moderate to major flooding in Dumaresq Creek throughout the day on the 6th.
