MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW APRIL 2017

April 2017 was a cool, cloudy and dry month.

After the unusually high rainfall in the previous month, April was much drier with a total of just 22.0 millimetres, about half the average. Most of the rain (17.0 mm) fell in two days, the 25th and 26th. It was a cloudy month resulting in day temperatures being below normal, although overnight minimums were close to normal. There were no notable extremes.

The first frosts of the year occurred on the 29th and 30th bringing to and end a frost-free period of 184 days since the last frost on 26th October 2016.

Winds were mostly light easterlies which is normal for April.

There were no noteworthy events.
