MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW JULY 2025

July 2025 was a wet, cold and partly cloudy month.

The rainfall total of 79.2 millimetres was 32 mm higher than the average making it the wettest July since 2012 (97.0 mm). Most of the rain fell in the second half of the month with the highest daily fall being 24.8 mm on the 18th. There was a 12 day period with no rain and mostly sunny weather from the 3rd to the 14th, after which mostly rainy conditions returned for the remainder of the month.

Day temperatures were close to normal, but overnight minimums were higher than normal due to numerous cloudy nights. One exception was -7.1C on the 17th which was Armidale's coldest minimum for two years. There were three cold outbreaks - from the 1st to the 3rd, the 18th, and the 27th to 28th.

Due to the many cloudy nights frosts were fewer than normal and less severe than normal for July.

Winds were predominantly moderate westerlies which is normal during the winter months.

There was one thunderstorm on the 23rd, and no hail or snow.

There were no noteworthy events.
