MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW MARCH 2020

March 2020 was a warm, cloudy and damp month with mostly light falls of rain.

The rainfall total of 59.4 millimetres was six millimetres less than the average with mostly light falls throughout the month with the exception of the evening of the 25th when 25.8 mm fell during and following thunderstorms.

Numerous cloudy days and nights kept day temperatures lower than normal and overnight temperatures higher than normal. There were no notable extremes.

There were only eight sunny days, no hail or frosts, and winds were predominantly light to moderate easterlies.

There were no noteworthy events.
