MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW MAY 2017

May 2017 was a cool and dry month with light winds.

The rainfall total of 35.0 millimetres was 8 mm higher than the average with the heaviest fall of 16.4 mm on the 28th. All other falls were light.

Temperatures were close to normal with no notable extremes.

Prevailing winds were westerlies and were much lighter than normal.

There was no hail or snow.

There were no noteworthy events.
