

MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW
NOVEMBER 2020

November 2020 was a warm mostly sunny month, but conditions were very dry. The rain total of just 15.2 millimetres was 67 mm lower than the average. It was the driest November since 1982 (9.8 mm) with all falls being very light except for 8.8 mm from a thunderstorm on the 22nd. Day temperatures were well above normal with maximums of 30.0 degrees or higher on seven days. Overnight minimums were close to normal, and there were no notable extremes. There was only one thunderstorm during the month on the 23rd, no hail or frosts, and prevailing winds were light to moderate westerlies which is normal for this time of year.

There were no noteworthy events.
